

Note: this classification of health IT standards types has been developed by the Health Information Technology Standards Panel (HITSP, www.hitsp.org) in 2006.


HIT Standardization Phases

- Standard development and maintenance
- Standards harmonization and testing
- Standards certification
- Standards adoption

HIT Standardization Phases and Entities

- Priority setting -----> *Past:* AHIC
Now: HIT Policy Committee and HIT Standards Committee
- Standard development and maintenance -----> Standards development organizations, for example—HL7, LOINC, X12, NUBC, NUCC, etc.
- Standards harmonization and testing -----> *Past:* Health Information Technology Standards Panel (HITSP)
Now: Integrating Healthcare Enterprise (IHE)
- Standards certification -----> Certification Commission for Health Information Technology (CCHIT)
- Standards adoption -----> US
