The purpose of this demonstration is to explain the features and potential uses of AAMSI's recently launched on-line electronic publication.

The on-line journal allows medical practitioners and researchers to communicate with one another and exchange diagnosis and treatment algorithms, software, and protocols, information, manuscripts, and news. It acts as a clearinghouse on computer applications in medical care and provides an efficient, timely medium for publishing materials of interest to members.

The journal is a menu driven, hierarchial publication that allows its readers to select from many different items of interest. In general these items include:

- Vendor Information
- Meetings of Interest

- Journal Article Abstracts and Book Reviews
- Editorial Comments
