Many items were killed to the ground in the early freeze. We have not one Rugosa nor Bud-ded Rose to offer. Our Climbers came through in pretty good shape. Broadleaved Ever-greens suffered badly, and are not offered here except in Lining-Out stock, which are in pots, snug under glass. Our famous field grown Conifer liners look pretty sick, and we are going to withhold them until we see how they come out of it. Haven't been able to do any work outside in about two weeks as this goes to press. But WE ARE STILL IN BUSINESS, and eventually we will get your present orders filled. The items listed in this bulletin are mostly under cover, and in good shape. Hope we will be allowed by the railways to ship without further delay this spring.

These offerings are at the 100 rate, so if possible, please favor us with orders for no less than fifty plants, assorted any way you like. If you're in a jam, however, and need only a few, we won't turn down the business!
