The first recital featured song cycles by German, French and British composers covering themes of love and loss. The second recital, *Gypsy Songs*, examined how nineteenth-century composers used Romany music to establish a nationalistic musical identity. The final recital compared important American musical theatre composers with their classical contemporaries.
