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Geography and hosts of the wood decay fungi *Fomes fasciatus* and *Fomes fomentarius* in the United States

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Abstract: Comprehensive United States county distribution maps of *Fomes fasciatus* and *F. fomentarius* were developed based on peer-reviewed publications, records from mycological herbaria and collections made for this study. The geographic distribution was expanded for both species to include a total of seven counties in five states not included in previous publications and records. North Carolina and Tennessee were the only states where both species occurred, but their distributions did not overlap when resolved to the county level. Both fungi occurred on a diverse range of hardwood tree hosts, and in this study, 11 and 17 new hosts associations were identified for *F. fasciatus* and *F. fomentarius*, respectively. The extension of host distributions beyond the known range for each fungus suggests that other delimiting factors may contribute to the distribution of *F. fasciatus* and *F. fomentarius*.

Introduction: The wood decay fungi *Fomes fasciatus* (Sw.) Cooke and *F. fomentarius* (L.) J. Kickx f. cause white heart rot in multiple species of trees and play important roles in forest ecology. These fungi occur in the United States and other areas of the world. Both species are associated with a variety of perennial woody plant hosts and produce basidiocarps on at least 23 tree species in over 10 different genera in the United States (Farr and Rossman 2012, Gilbertson and Ryvarden 1986, Overholts 1953). In the United States, *F. fasciatus* has been reported to occur predominantly on oak (*Quercus* spp.) and hickory (*Carya* spp.), while *F. fomentarius* typically occurs on birch (*Betula* spp.), beech (*Fagus* spp.), and maple (*Acer* spp.) (Farr and Rossman 2012). Both species are distinguished based on distinctive sclerids in the granular core of the basidiocarps, basidiocarp shape, mean basidiospore size, species of tree host, and geographic location within the United States (Gilbertson and Ryvarden 1986, Ryvarden 1991, Ryvarden and Gilbertson 1993).

Geographic distributions by state show that both fungi occur in North Carolina and Tennessee (Gilbertson and Ryvarden 1986). However, distributions by county for North Carolina did not overlap (Grand and Vernia 2006). The primary objective of this study was to better resolve the distribution to the county level for both species of *Fomes* in the United States.

Materials and Methods: United States distribution maps were compiled by county based on a critical assessment of 169 and 731 records for *F. fasciatus* and *F. fomentarius*, respectively (Table). These records were from online databases, consultation with curators or staff at mycological herbaria, and publications (Bates 2006, Gilbertson and Ryvarden 1986, Grand and Vernia 2006, Popp and Lindquist 2006, Purdy and Purdy 1982). Synonyms for *F. fasciatus* included: *F. marmoratus* (Berk. & M. A. Curtis) Cooke, *F. sclerodermeus* (Lév.) Cooke, and *Elvingia fasciata* (Sw.) Murrill. A synonym for

F. fomentarius was *Elvingia fomentaria* (L.) Murrill. Seven specimens (BPI— 229681, 229683, 229812, 229833, 229835, 229987, 871256) from United States National Fungus Collections (BPI) were examined. Species lists of host plants associated with both species of fungi were compiled from herbaria records and publications. County information was inferred from location information (e.g., state park or city) if counties were not listed in herbaria records.

Additional collections of *F. fasciatus* and *F. fomentarius* were collected from spring 2010 to fall 2011 and used in compiling and determining fungal distributions and host associations. Volunteers contributed 26 basidiocarps of *F. fasciatus* and 152 basidiocarps of *F. fomentarius*, which were examined in the laboratory, identified using taxonomic treatments of Gilbertson and Ryvarden (1986) and Overholts (1953), and deposited into the Larry F. Grand Mycological Herbarium at North Carolina State University (NCSLG). Nomenclature and authorities were from Index Fungorum (CABI et al. 2012) for fungi and The Plant List (2010) for trees. Herbaria abbreviations follow that of Thiers (2012). Distributions of the tree species most commonly associated with *F. fasciatus* and *F. fomentarius* in the United States were from The Biota of North American Project (Kartesz 2011, Lichvar and Kartesz 2009).

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


Fig. 1. County distribution of *Fomes fasciatus* in the United States




Fig. 2. County distribution of *Fomes fomentarius* in the United States

Results: The geographic distribution for *F. fasciatus* (Fig. 1) was expanded to include new reports in two counties in South Carolina (Anderson and Darlington) and for *F. fomentarius* (Fig. 2) to include counties in four states (Illinois—Douglas; Indiana—Clark, Marshal; Kentucky—Fayette; Missouri—St. Louis). Specimens collected for this study added three counties (South Carolina—Anderson; Georgia—Bleckley, Twiggs) for *F. fasciatus* and 10 counties (Pennsylvania—Union; Michigan—Alger, Grand Traverse, Leelanau; Minnesota—Lake; New York—Cortland, Oneida; Virginia—Floyd; Wisconsin—Bayfield, Burnett) for *F. fomentarius*.

fomentarius. Identification was confirmed for collections from BPI for *F. fasciatus* specimens (BPI—229833) and *F. fomentarius* specimens (BPI—229683, 871256). Four collections (BPI—229681, 229987, 229812, 229835) identified as *F. fomentarius* were found to be *F. fasciatus* upon examination.

Eleven host species of *F. fasciatus* and 17 host species of *F. fomentarius*, not currently listed by the USDA Systematic Mycology and Microbiology Laboratory Fungus-Host Database (Farr and Rossman 2012) were identified from herbaria database records. New host species for *F. fasciatus* were: *Carya illinoiensis* (Wangenh.) K. Koch, *Casuarina glauca* Siebold ex Spreng., *Celtis mississippiensis* Bosc, *Citrus sinensis* Osbeck, *Gleditsia aquatica* Marshall, *Gordonia lasianthus* L., *Magnolia virginiana* L., *Persea borbonia* Spreng., *Prunus domestica* L., *Quercus arizonica* Sarg., and *Q. falcata* Michx. New host species for *F. fomentarius* were: *Acer macrophyllum* Pursh, *Aesculus sylvatica* W. Bartram, *Alnus incana* (L.) Moench, *A. oregona* Nutt., *A. sinuata* (Regel) Rydb., *A. tenuifolia* Nutt., *Betula lenta* L., *B. nigra* L., *Carpinus caroliniana* Walter, *Fraxinus americana* L., *F. nigra* Marsh., *Populus balsamifera* L., *P. deltoides* W. Bartram ex Marshall, *P. grandidentata* Michx., *Q. velutina* Lam., and *Ulmus americana* L. One of our collections of *F. fasciatus* on *Q. acutissima* Carruthers, represents the first record on that host.

Discussion: North Carolina represents a unique geographic transition area for these species because it represents the northern limit for *F. fasciatus* and the southern limit for *F. fomentarius* (Gilbertson and Ryvarden 1986, Grand and Vernia 2006). While both species occur in North Carolina, they have not been found in the same county or physiographic region of the state (Grand and Vernia 2006).

In support of the findings of Grand and Vernia (2006), the United States distribution of *F.*

fasciatus and *F. fomentarius* when resolved to the county level was not found to occur within the same county or region. *Fomes fasciatus* occurs in the Coastal Plain and *F. fomentarius* in the Blue Ridge Mountains of North Carolina. There was one record of *F. fasciatus* from Tennessee (BPI—231792) and records of *F. fomentarius* from California (BPI—229814) and Rhode Island (CFMR—FP-8635), but the collection data was insufficient to specify the county.

Host range, elevation, latitude, and climate determine the distribution of wood decay fungi with the most important environmental factors being temperature and precipitation (Gilbertson 1980, Overholts 1939). Gilbertson (1980) and Overholts (1939) provided several examples of wood decay fungi with distributions that cover a smaller area than their associated host tree species distribution. The distribution of several common tree species associated with *F. fasciatus* and *F. fomentarius* extends beyond the fungal distributions reported in this study suggesting that other delimiting factors may contribute to the occurrence of these fungi. The distribution of three tree species most commonly associated with *F. fasciatus* in the United States extends north along the east coast into New Jersey for *Q. nigra* L. and *Q. falcata* and west into Kansas, Iowa, and several Californian counties for *C. illinoiensis*. The distribution of the three tree species most commonly associated with *F. fomentarius* in North Carolina extend south into the northern counties of South Carolina and Georgia for *B. alleghaniensis* Britton, northern Alabama for *B. lenta*, and into counties bordering the gulf coast of the United States for *Fagus grandifolia* Ehrh. *Acer rubrum* L., a host for both fungal species, is widely distributed throughout the eastern United States as far south as southern Florida and eastern Texas and north into Québec and Ontario, Canada.

Few detailed distribution maps exist for species of wood decay fungi in the United States. This study provides the most comprehensive

assessment of the distribution of two wood decay fungi and may serve as a guide for more definitive distribution maps of other fungi. The establishment of our comprehensive distribution maps and accompanying information will provide an improved database for more rigorous statistical analyses to assess and critically examine the distribution of *F. fasciatus* and *F. fomentarius* in response to changes in the environment.
